Dear Resident,


Please be advised, we will be repaving the entire Sandy Beach neighborhood. This project is scheduled to start Monday, October 22nd. "No Parking" signs will be in place. The road will remain open but expect minor delays when driving in your neighborhood. Please obey the flagmen and drive carefully. Your patience during this process is appreciated.

The following roads will be part of this year's project:

Greenway, Sandy Beach, Wallace, Warner, South Park, Middle, North Park, Garden Parkway, Fieldstone Drive and Redway. This project is a hot mix asphalt overlay

This project will be done in 3 phases. The initial phase is scheduled to start on Monday, October 22nd. Milling of the existing road bed and will be completed in 2 days. The binder layer of asphalt will then be put down followed by final asphalt top driving surface.

Weather delays can occur so this paving schedule could be altered a bit. Please call us with any questions or concerns. Thank you.

## Highway Department Right of Way Information

The Town of Grand Island Highway Department would like to issue this friendly reminder to citizens of our community. Obstacles in the Town's right-of-way can be dangerous to people and to motor vehicles alike. We ask you to please remove any obstacles that you may have within 10 feet of the edge of the paved roadway. Any obstacle within this area is a potential liability to you the homeowner. This includes rocks, wooden posts, metal posts, etc. Please consider this notice as the Town's written warning.

It is imperative that these obstacles are removed no later than **November 16<sup>th</sup>**. Any objects remaining in the Town's right-of-way after this date will have to be removed by the Town of Grand Island Highway Department for safety purposes.
