










MATERIALS		WHAT TO PLACE IN TOTE	WHAT TO PLACE IN THE TRASH
	<b>NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES &amp; CATALOGS</b>	Anything that comes with your normal newspaper. Magazines delivered to your home or purchased at a newsstand. All catalogs, phone books, and junk mail.	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper, wrapping paper. <b>ANY FOOD SOILED PAPER</b>
	<b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b>	Recycle all brown corrugated cardboard. Brown paper bags. Unsoiled pizza boxes. Box board (shoe boxes, gift boxes, cereal boxes).	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Waxed corrugated, cardboard lined with foam, and fridge/freezer cardboard, pop/beer cardboard.
	<b>GLASS BOTTLES</b>	All clear, green and brown food and beverage containers.	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Ceramic bottles and other ceramic items, flower pots, crystal light bulbs, mirror and window glass, heat resistant ovenware, hypodermic syringes, eyeglasses.
	<b>METAL CANS &amp; KITCHEN COOKWARE</b>	All metal food and beverage containers (cans). Metal lids, closure caps, aluminum pie tins. Pots, pans, tins and utensils.	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Silverware, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice or motor oil), small appliances, or tin foil. <b>DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TYPE OF BATTERY</b>
	<b>PLASTIC</b> Numbers  thru 	Plastic food, soap and beverage containers, rigid plastic, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, chairs, furniture, etc.	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Anti-freeze or motor oil containers, plates, tableware, medicine bottles, plexiglass, fast food containers.
	<b>MILK CARTONS JUICE CARTONS DRINK BOXES</b>	Gable top beverages. Containers including those with plastic spouts. Remove Lids	<b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Straws from drink boxes. Frozen food containers. Waxed paper or drink pouches.
	<b>Waste motor oil is to be returned to the service station or retail outlet where purchased and WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.</b>		

**MOVING? Remember the Tote stays with the house. For Customer Service or questions call: Republic Services 1-800-283-4220**

**WHERE to recycle: On your recycling day just put your tote out with your regular solid waste by 7:00 a.m. Rain or shine. Republic Services will pick up your recyclable materials. Recyclables and solid waste will be collected by separate trucks.**

**WHEN to recycle: Your recycling day will be your regular solid waste day every week. Just remember to put your filled tote out with your regular solid waste by 7:00 a.m. It's that easy! If your scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and the remainder of the week will be delayed one day.**

**WHEN WILL THE TOTE ARRIVE?**

Delivery began the week of May 12, 2014. Every eligible household will receive a wheeled tote for the new single stream recycling program. Tote will be delivered at the curb near an appropriate collection spot.

**WHEN CAN I START USING THE NEW RECYCLING TOTE?**

Totes collection will begin the week of June 1st.

**WILL THE TOTE HOLD ALL OF MY SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING?**

Yes, on average, the tote should be sufficient for homeowners if you recycle all the allowable materials, such as glass, plastic, cans, paper and cardboard.

**WILL MY RECYCLING PICK UP DATE CHANGE?**

No, it will be collected every week on trash day.

**WILL MY TRASH PICKUP DATE CHANGE?**

No, there are no changes on trash pickup.

**DO I HAVE TO FILL MY RECYCLING TOTE BEFORE I CAN PUT IT OUT TO BE PICKED UP?**

No, you do not have to have a full recycling tote in order for it to be picked up. Ideally, we would like to remove a full tote to ensure a more productive program and reduce our carbon footprint.

**WHAT CAN I PLACE IN THE RECYCLING TOTE?**

Place only normal household recycling in the wheeled recycle tote.

**WILL ANY RECYCLABLES LEFT OUTSIDE OF THE TOTE BE PICKED UP?**

Only large rigid plastic items that will not fit in the tote should be left beside the tote. Please ensure that you are maximizing your usage of the recycling tote.

**HOW CAN I MAXIMIZE MY RECYCLING TOTE USAGE?**

The most common way to maximize the recycling tote is by ensuring that you break down all cardboard recyclables. If you find that you are still having an excess of recycling, try compacting the soft plastic containers before placing them into the recycling tote.

**WHO OWNS THE TOTE?**

The tote remains the property of Republic Services and stays with the house when you move. Do not paint or deface the tote.

**WILL I BE ABLE TO USE MY OWN CONTAINERS?**

No. Due to safety and liability issues, residents will not be able to put out recycling in their own containers. Only the tote supplied by Republic Services, for recycling, will be picked up.

**WHERE DO I PLACE THE TOTE ON MY RECYCLE DAY?**

Place the tote 3 feet from your trash containers, parked cars, bulk items, fences, mailboxes and other obstructions. Unhook, and remove, any temporary bungee cords or tie-downs you may have used to secure the lid before setting the wheeled tote out on collection day. Totes must be placed out on collection days by 7:00 am.

# HELPFUL HINTS

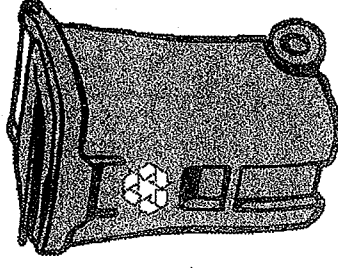
## SOLID WASTE

- ◆ Weekly collection of solid waste 10 items (bags and/or container) limit, recyclables (totes supplied by Republic Services) & trash/bulk items (1 per week), shall be placed within 5 feet of the street edge or curb prior to 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- ◆ Containers, bags and/or bushels shall **not** exceed 60 pounds in weight, excluding trash/bulk items.
- ◆ All CFC (chlorofluorocarbon) units must have gases properly removed and have a sticker approved by DEC & EPA regulations attached to the unit.
- ◆ Doors Removed - Refrigerator, freezer, iceboxes and other items with tight fitting doors shall be removed. Locks on all locking appliances shall be disabled or removed.
- ◆ Bundled items securely tied, must **not** exceed 4 feet in length or 4 inches in diameter.
- ◆ One person must be able to easily handle these items.
- ◆ Materials left behind by private contractors will **not** be collected.
- ◆ One automobile or smaller tire (rim removed) is allowed each week.
- ◆ Christmas trees throughout the Holiday Season will be collected and are exempt from the 4 feet in length rule.

## RECYCLING

- ◆ Acceptable materials (see reverse side) are to be placed in totes provided by Republic Services within 3 feet of the street edge or curb prior to 7:00 a.m. on your collection day and separate from the solid waste.
- ◆ If you are moving, please remember the tote stays with the house.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

- ◆ New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. If your collection day is on or follows any of these holidays during the week, your collection will be one (1) day later.
