The procedure for this application is as follows: The Application and any supporting documentation will be filed with the Town Clerk with appropriate fees. The Town Clerk will distribute copies of the application to the Town Board and the Town's Conservation Advisory Board for consideration of criteria set forth in 239-6B and 239-6E of the Town Code. Within 31 days of receipt, the Conservation Advisory Board may make a written recommendation to the Town Board for approval of the Trapping Permit as requested, or with such modifications as the Conservation Advisory Board determines necessary and appropriate, or denial. Thereafter, and within 62 days of receipt of a completed application, or such longer period as may be agreed upon the applicant, the Town Board may approve the Trapping Permit as requested, or with such modifications as the Town Board determines necessary and appropriate, or may deny the application. The Town Board shall consider the impacts of the proposed permit to the health, safety, and welfare of the community, the surrounding land uses, the current and potential use of the property at issue, the qualifications and experience of the applicant(s), and any other factor that the Town Board deems reasonable.
